

Feast of Justice Programs, September 2020

Feast of Justice has 4 types of programs: City Box, Community Cupboard, Senior Boxes and Baby Supplies.

The **City Box program**: Thursdays only, 10am-12pm Mixed boxes

No ID is needed. Registered guests and the general public can come as often as you need the food.

The **Community Cupboard program** (non-perishable and perishable food packages) ALL OUTSIDE

1. Please remember to maintain social distancing and wear masks when possible. We want to keep our community safe!
2. There is only one line. The first 90 minutes of distribution are reserved for appointments. Please wait at the designated spaces. Please do not come before your scheduled time. Everyone receives the same food, regardless of your number in line.

3. Guest cannot save space for others or leave carts or other objects to save your place. Do not allow other guests to break into line in front of you.
4. All guests must be registered and have a Feast of Justice card. All cards will be scanned, so we can track your usage of the program.
5. Guests can come to receive food up to 2 TIMES a week, but only ONE CAN BE WITH AN APPOINTMENT. The second visit must be as a walk-up. If a guest comes more frequently, our system will block them from receiving food.
6. There is no parking on Sackett Street. That space is reserved for loading food. You may bring your car there AFTER you receive your food to load only, not to wait for your food. NO ONE can use the driveway.
7. Please do not leave food or boxes in the driveway or on other people's property.

Making an Appointment

Guests can make an appointment online, through either a computer or a smartphone at Feastofjustice.org. Once you have requested an appointment, you will receive an email that it is pending approval. Once we confirm your eligibility, a confirmation email is sent to you. Please do not submit a second request while the confirmation is pending. You will also receive a text message reminder one day before your appointment. Further directions to make an appointment are on the website or ask a volunteer for information in your language.

Senior boxes

Senior boxes are available to those who have been approved by the state to receive a box. Guests must be 60 years old or older. and meet income level requirements. Ask a volunteer for more information or look on our website for details. This is for any family member listed in the household. The boxes are available from the 2nd through the 4th weeks of the month on a first come basis. Guests may only receive one box each month.

The **Baby Supplies program** (diapers and baby supplies—Tuesdays 9-12, Wednesdays 4-7, and Saturdays 1-4)

1. Only registered Feast of Justice guests with babies listed in their registration can receive diapers and baby supplies. Guests must show their Feast of Justice registration card and it will be scanned in to determine the number of eligible children. There is NOT a separate line; guests will receive their diapers when they are signed in for food. There is no separate line for guests just wanting diapers.
2. A household can only receive diapers ONCE a week.
3. Each registered child will receive one pack of diapers.
4. Feminine pads and products are also available upon request.

Coming Soon

Feast of Justice is working to bring more programs to our guests. We will post information as new programs begin. You can watch for them on our website, feastofjustice.org, Facebook page, and email announcements. We will also distribute flyers at food distribution. Home Deliveries

We hope to restart home deliveries in October. We will begin with Seniors and disabled guests. This will be based on need and availability of drivers.

Re-registration

We are currently beginning to re-register those guests with temporary cards. Guests who are already registered with a white card need not re-register yet, but we hope to begin your re-registration soon. Guests with temporary cards need to re-apply before their card expires. You can find directions to re-register on our website: feastofjustice.org or ask a volunteer for information when you come for food.

Guests may schedule an appointment at feastofjustice.org or in person when signing in for food.

Flu shots clinic

We are planning an outdoor flu shot clinic to help you be safe, especially during this pandemic. Details soon.

SNAP Enrollment

The federal SNAP program helps low income families with food support at local grocery stores. We are working on an event where you can apply for SNAP on site—with bilingual counselors available to provide assistance. Keep watch for details.
